PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE: As you know, last week, we held an important community engagement evening to talk about tuition as well as the past and future financial story of St. Joseph's. 2. February 11 -15 at 8 am St Joseph's Pre Kindergarten program

3. **February 12 at 8 am** everyone on a first come, first serve basis. We will leave this open until all spots are filled. Children must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2025. <u>NET CANADA - HOST FAMILIES NEEDED</u>: The NET (National Evangelization team) is coming April 1st and is in need of a host family or two. There will be 8 young adults 4 female and 4 male. If you are able to offer your home to host a few of them for the night please contact the school. Thank you!

HOT LUNCH: Just a reminder that hot lunch cards are \$60.00 each and that will get you 10 lunches. Cash or cheque only, no e transfers as this is a fundraiser for the PSG.

IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY: In the event of a emergency before school starts, we will communicate via email and Facebook if school is to be cancelled or important information needs to be communicated. We will also have staff on site (if safe) to assist students who have walked to school or families who have missed any communications. In the event we need to evacuate the school and dismiss students, students will be taken to the church and families will be called at that time.

PARKING LOT PROCEDURES: We keep getting complaints about unsafe parking and drop offs. Remember these rules are in place to keep students and others safe while walking in the parking lot. If you have questions please contact the office for clarification.

-All traffic is to enter via First Avenue and exit via Broadway Avenue

-Vehicles are to follow the **one way** arrow and drive slowly, single file.

- Vehicles are NOT to be parked along the school building from the double doors along the chain link fence to the small hall. This is drop off traffic only. Please drop your children off at the stop sign not after.

-If a parent needs to get out of the vehicle for any reason, the vehicle must go park in a designated parking spot.

-Vehicles parked by the rectory are to have their headlights facing the school. (back in)

-Vehicles may park along the wooden fence, but must back in.

-Vehicles are to stop for pedestrians and cyclists. There is a stop sign at the crosswalk.

-Cyclists and pedestrians are to cross the parking lot at the crosswalk only. All must walk.

-Crosswalks are to be used to reach parked vehicles.

-No Parking in the parking space in front of the Small Hall.

-No parking across from bus drop off (Manitoba St) - no parking zone for the whole block.

- No drop offs at the crosswalk on Manitoba - we've had several complaints regarding this.

DRESSING FOR THE WEATHER: As the weather changes, this is just a friendly reminder to ensure that children come to school with clothing appropriate for the weather, including rainy days and snowy days. Unless the rain is really coming down in torrents, and unless it gets very cold, children will still go outside when it showers or snows. Fresh air is a good thing!
